

OSHKOSH AND WINNEBAGO COUNTY UNEMPLOYMENT RATES CONTINUE TO DECLINE IN SEPTEMBER

For the sixth straight month, the unemployment rates for [Oshkosh](#) and [Winnebago County](#) saw declines in the month of September as reported by the Wisconsin DWD.

CITY OF OSHKOSH EMPLOYMENT DATA

The data indicated that the Unemployment Rate for September 2020 was 3.5%, down from a high of 14.3 percent in April. By comparison, the unemployment rate in September of 2019 was 2.9%. Oshkosh's September unemployment rate was one of the lowest of major cities across the State of Wisconsin.

There are currently 33,848 Oshkosh City residents working this September vs. 33,364 last year. In contrast, Oshkosh's April employment was 29,541 showing a positive employment trend increase of 4,307 since April, 2020. By comparison, Oshkosh's March 2020 employment was 33,048 before the effects of Covid-19 began impacting the economy.

WINNEBAGO COUNTY EMPLOYMENT DATA

The Winnebago County unemployment rate for September was 3.6%, down from a high of 14.2% in April of 2020. By comparison, the unemployment rate in September of 2019 was 2.7%.

There are currently 89,839 Winnebago County residents working this year vs. 88,556 last year, however, Winnebago County's April employment was 78,409, showing a positive employment trend increase of 11,430 from April to September 2020. By comparison, Winnebago County's March 2020 employment was 87,717 before the effects of Covid-19 began impacting the economy.

WISCONSIN EMPLOYMENT DATA

The Wisconsin September 2020 unemployment rate was 4.7% vs 14.6% in April of 2020. Statewide employment is still over 29,024 less than last year at this time, however it is up 355,000 from April of 2020.
